COMMUNITY NOTICE

The NSW Government is investing \$582 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure has engaged Lendlease Building to carry out the early works to prepare the site for the new Hospital buildings.

Early works started on the Cudgen Road site in July 2019. Completion of the new Tweed Valley Hospital is scheduled for late 2022 and the Hospital will open its doors to patients in 2023.

Site closure

The site will close from Saturday 21 December 2019 and re-open on Monday 6 January 2020.

The Tweed Valley Hospital Project Team would like to thank the community for its patience during the important work to prepare the site for building the new hospital.

Keeping the site secure

During the closure a range of measures will be in place to maintain a safe and secure site including:

- Completion of the local road work on the Turnock Street roundabout including removal of the safety barriers and opening of the new pedestrian pathway
- Security monitoring of the site area
- Continuous dust monitoring and implementation of dust control measures, including treating soil stockpiles and other exposed areas with a citrus-based binder.

2020 Lookahead

Starting in the New Year we will be:

- Continuing earthwork and piling work
- · Completing temporary construction access points
- Starting in-ground services work
- Starting vegetation remediation work.
