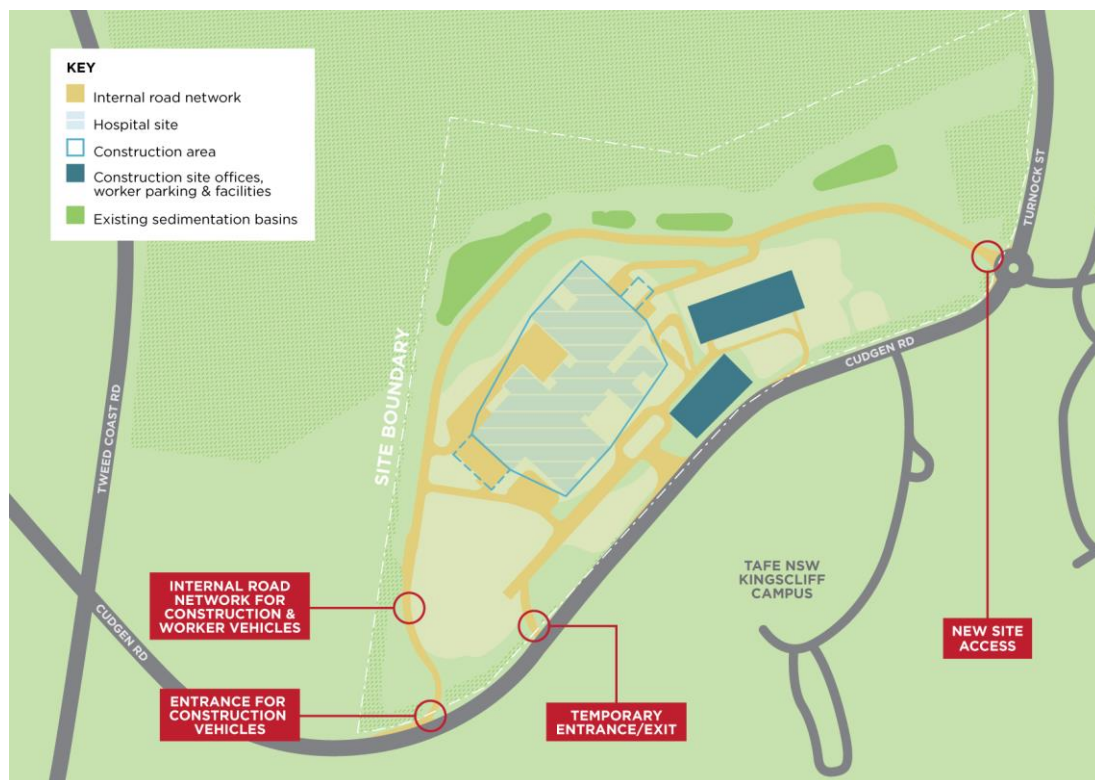


COMMUNITY NOTICE

Upcoming work

As part of the on-going early works to prepare the site for construction of the Hospital buildings, Lendlease will carry out work on Cudgen Road and Turnock Street to build new vehicle access points to the site.

This will involve building a new permanent left turning lane on Cudgen Road into the hospital site at the south western boundary and a new access point from the Turnock Street roundabout.



Date of work

The work will start **mid October 2019** and continue for about 12 weeks, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Safety

Safety is our number one priority. Temporary changes to road and pedestrian conditions on Cudgen Road and Turnock Street will be in place during the work, including pedestrian detours and speed limit reductions.

What to expect

Residents and road users may notice an increase in trucks accessing the site and experience short travel delays on Cudgen Road and Turnock Street as speed limits are reduced in the vicinity of the construction. Both lanes on Cudgen Road will remain open for the majority of the work duration and no detours will be required.

Due to the nature of the work some localised noise and vibration may occur during the use of heavy machinery including vibratory rollers and asphaltting equipment.

There will be clear signage around the work areas.

Please factor in additional travel times as there may be slight delays.

Construction hours

Our construction working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturday. Saturday morning works may be required.

No work will take place outside of these hours or public holidays without prior notice and approvals.
