The NSW Government is investing \$673.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. The Tweed Valley Hospital will open its doors to patients in 2023.

Site activities during Christmas break

The site will close from 5pm Wednesday 23 December 2020 and re-open on Monday 4 January 2021.

Keeping the site secure

During this period, we will maintain a safe and secure site including:

- Security monitoring of the site area
- Continuous dust monitoring and implementation of dust control measures, including treating soil stockpiles and other exposed areas with a citrus-based binder.

2021 Lookahead

Construction works for Tweed Valley Hospital will continue in the new year with the following works:

- Installation of electrical and hydraulic in-ground services
- Concreting activities and deliveries to construct the building structures
- Preparation for and delivery of the first of three tower cranes to site in February/March 2021.
