TWEED VALLEY HOSPITAL PROJECT APRIL 2021





WORKS NOTIFICATION

The NSW Government is investing \$673.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main hospital buildings. The new hospital is on track to open to patients in 2023.

Permanent underground power supply installation, Cudgen Road - Commencing 6 April 2021

Work will commence on 6 April 2021 to install the new permanent underground power supply for the hospital from an existing substation on Cudgen Road to a new substation within the hospital site.

These works will take approximately six months to complete.

The power supply alignment will be approximately 2km in length and will cross Cudgen Road outside the existing substation, follow the southern side of Cudgen Road to the Tweed Coast Road intersection, then cross Cudgen Road into the hospital site.

What to expect

- Geotechnical bore holes at various points along the alignment to confirm ground conditions and the appropriate construction method.
- A combination of open trenching and underboring activities (based on the ground conditions) to install underground power supply.
- Multiple work sites along the alignment working simultaneously.
- To maintain safety, traffic control will be in place on the westbound lane of Cudgen Road, with traffic under a stop/go arrangement when required. Motorists may experience minor traffic delays.
- Equipment will include a boring machine, vac truck, bobcat, dump trucks and excavators.
- Activities will be undertaken during standard work hours of Monday to Friday 7am 6pm, and Saturday 8am -1pm.
