



Concrete pour rescheduled - Tweed Valley Hospital project

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main hospital buildings. The new hospital is on track to open to patients in 2023.

Out of hours concrete pour rescheduled due to weather

Please note, the concrete pour for the linear accelerator bunker has been rescheduled to **Friday 15 October** due to inclement weather. To ensure continuity of supply and concrete integrity, the pour will take place between **4am and 6pm**.

What to expect

Concreting activities will commence from **4am** including trucks arriving to site and concreting activities taking place. An increase in noise at this time may be experienced. Monitoring controls will be in place to maintain levels within permissible limits and Lendlease will minimise impacts where possible.

If the concrete pour is delayed due to weather again, it will take place on the next available day. Thank you for your patience during these works.
