

Upcoming out of hours work – Tweed Valley Hospital project

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main hospital buildings. The new hospital is on track to open to patients in 2023.

Out of hours concrete pours

As part of construction for the linear accelerator bunker, which will be used to deliver radiotherapy services once the hospital opens, three large concrete pours will be required. The first pour is scheduled for **Tuesday 12 October** with two more pours required by **15 December 2021**. To ensure continuity of supply and concrete integrity, these pours will take place between **4am and 6pm**.

What to expect

Concreting activities will commence from 4am including trucks arriving to site and concreting activities taking place. An increase in noise at this time may be experienced. Monitoring controls will be in place to maintain levels within permissible limits and Lendlease will minimise impacts where possible.
