

Upcoming out of hours work – Tweed Valley Hospital project

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main hospital buildings. The new hospital is on track to open to patients in 2023.

Out of hours concrete pours during February and March 2022

To construct the roof of the linear accelerator bunker, which will be used to deliver radiotherapy services once the hospital opens, two large concrete pours will be required. The first concrete pour will take place on **Wednesday 23 February 2022** and the second pour will take place by **31 March 2022**. To ensure continuity of supply and concrete integrity, the pours will take place between **4.30am and 6pm**. If these activities are delayed due to weather, they will take place on the next available day.

What to expect

Concreting activities will commence from 4.30am including trucks arriving to site and concreting activities taking place. An increase in noise at this time may be experienced. Monitoring controls will be in place to maintain levels within permissible limits and Lendlease will minimise impacts where possible.
