Kingscliff Ambulance Station Out of Hours Works Notification

With works progressing on the new Kingscliff Ambulance Station, a significant structural milestone for this project is the pouring of large concrete ramp slab.

To minimise delays to this project, this work will be completed outside of normal working hours.

Please see below summary of extended working hours.

Pour Week of 26 th Feb 2024	The concrete pour for the Ambulance Station access
	ramp will be commencing week of 26th February
	between the hours of 4:45am and 6pm, weather
	permitting.

What to expect:

- Works will be undertaken on the new Kingscliff Ambulance Station site outside of the regular working hours. Disturbances of regular hours will be between 4:45am to 7am.
- Equipment in use will include concrete boom pump, concrete trucks, lighting, generator, and concreting equipment.
- There will be some noise impacts for properties in the immediate vicinity during these works. FKG will work to minimise these impacts as much as possible.
- Disturbances to the nearby area will be minimised with all works being maintained within the construction site.
