

Getting to Tweed Valley Hospital

The Tweed Valley Hospital is centrally located within the Tweed-Byron region at 771 Cudgen Road, Cudgen. Located close to the motorway and adjacent to Tweed Coast Road, the hospital is easily accessed by car and public transport.

By car

Follow the M1 to Chinderah, and take the exit towards Cudgen/Kingscliff.

Continue on Tweed Coast Road and turn left at the intersection of Tweed Coast Road and Cudgen Road.

Drop off areas and parking

Drop off bays are located at the hospital's three entrances; the main entrance, the emergency department, and the east entrance.

Staff, patients and visitors will have access to over 1,200 free on-site car parking spaces at the Tweed Valley Hospital. This includes a multi-deck car park, an at-grade car park, accessible parking spaces and short-term parking facilities.

There is long-term capacity for up to 1,500 car spaces on the Tweed Valley Hospital site.

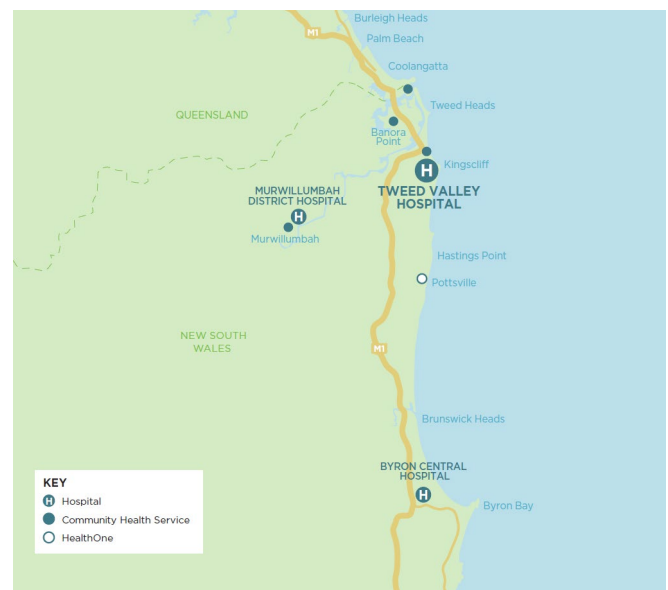
Public transport

The Tweed Valley Hospital is located on a public transport route. Bus stops are located on both sides of Cudgen Road, directly in front of the hospital, with a pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights.

Tweed Shire's public bus network services the Tweed Valley Hospital on the following routes:

- Route 601 Tweed Heads West to Kingscliff TAFE and Tweed Valley Hospital. This service operates every 30 minutes, from 5am to 11pm weekdays.
- Route 603 Tweed City to Pottsville connects the Tweed Valley Hospital to the Tweed Coast suburbs. This service runs hourly everyday, from 5am to 9pm.
- Route 609 Murwillumbah to Kingscliff TAFE and Tweed Valley Hospital. This route has 5 weekday and 9 weekend services.

Taxis and rideshares

A taxi rank is located at the main entry to Tweed Valley Hospital. Taxis and rideshare vehicles will be able to utilise this set down/pick up area.

Active transport

The hospital connects with established pedestrian and cycle routes in the area.

In the multi-deck car park, there are end-of-trip facilities for staff which include secure bicycle parking, showers and toilets, changing room facilities and lockers; as well as power outlets in proximity to bicycle racks to enable bike charging for electric bikes.

There are also bicycle racks for public use located close to building entries.
