

TWEED VALLEY HOSPITAL PROJECT

Construction works notification

JULY 2022

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main hospital buildings. The new hospital is on track to open to patients in 2023.

Traffic changes on Cudgen Road from 7 July 2022

The widening of Cudgen Road as part of the Tweed Valley Hospital project is continuing with traffic changes required to enable the next section of the widening works. From 7 July, weather pending, several traffic changes will take place:

- The eastbound bus stop will move approximately 20-30 metres to the east.
- The restricted right-hand turn and detour near the entry to TAFE will be removed with the normal traffic arrangement returned.
- Traffic barriers will be placed on Cudgen Road to narrow the lane, allowing a safe work area to construct the new road pavement.
- At the western end of the hospital site, traffic barriers will be in place to allow a safe work area to construct new drainage and kerbing.

These traffic arrangements will be in place for approximately six weeks, weather pending.

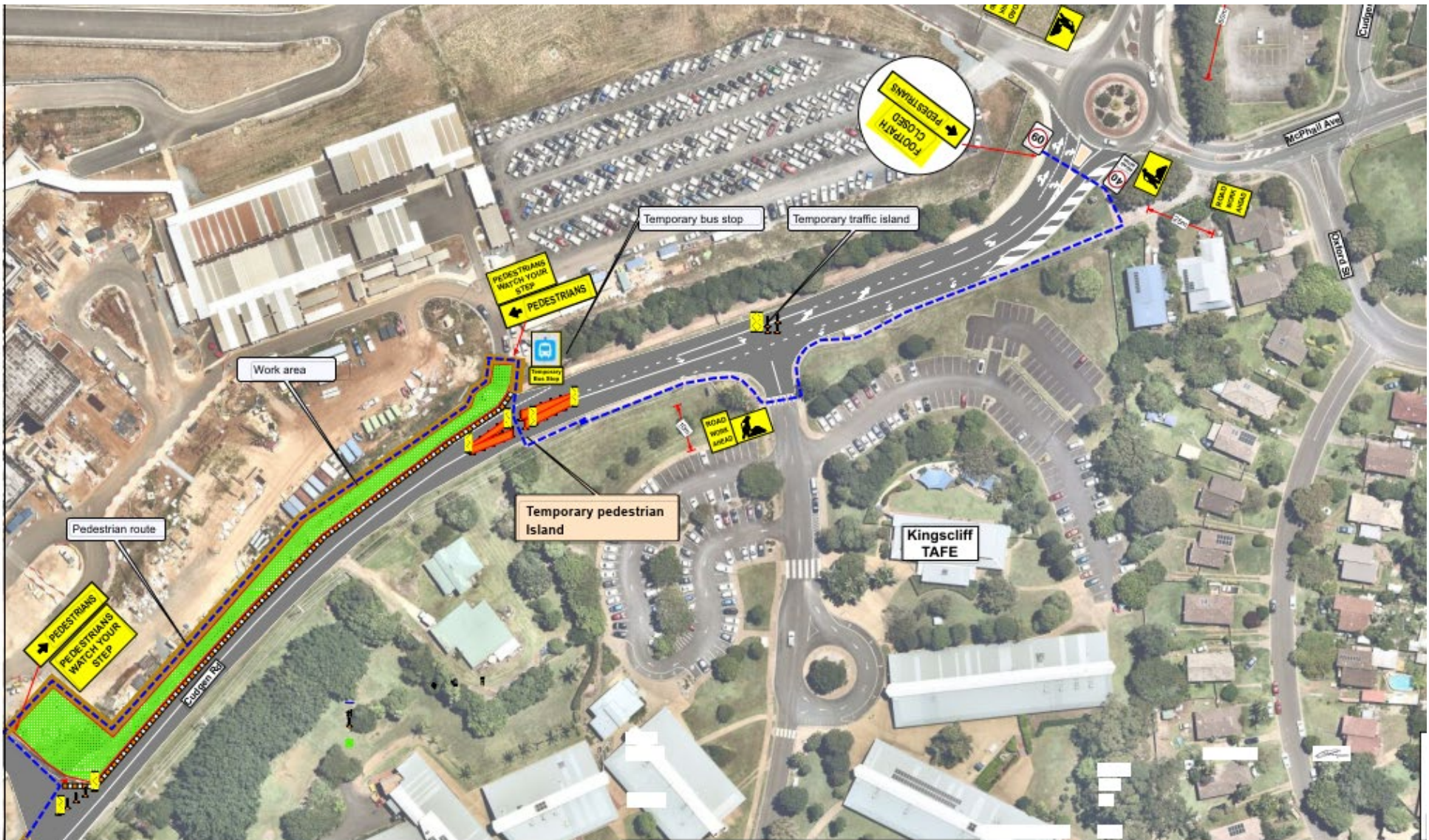
What to expect:

- The eastbound bus stop will move approximately 20-30 metres to the east.
- Pedestrians will be diverted to the southern side of Cudgen Road during these works with pedestrian islands in place to assist with safe road crossings.
- Reduced speed limit to 40km/h on Cudgen Road in the vicinity of the works.
- Signage in place to advise of footpath route diversion and reduced speed limits.
- Delays may be experienced due to the reduced speed limits. We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

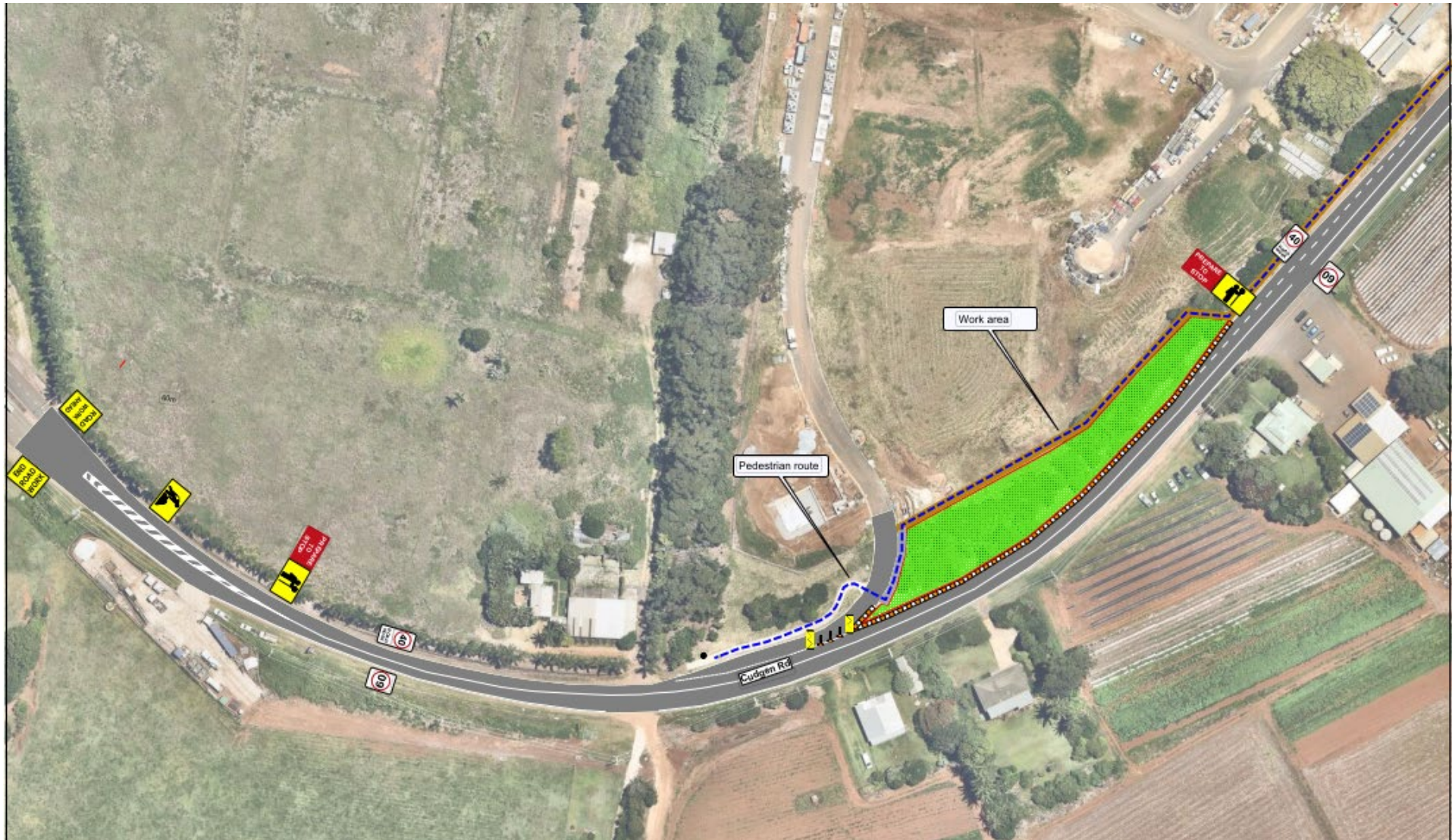
